THE PROJECT

The Bent Street Vehicle Access Ramp along the Altona and Seaholme foreshore was built to give access to the beach for the Altona Lifesaving Club, emergency services vehicles and beach grooming and seaweed collection vehicles. This freshly laid concrete needed to have a decorative concrete finish that could tolerate high foot and vehicle traffic, and have good durability. It also needed to be able to blend into the natural surrounding environment.

THE SOLUTION

The Dulux Avista Resurfacing System was chosen as it offers an excellent antislip finish and high durability – essential for this foreshore location and high level of vehicle and pedestrian traffic.
