

# Dulux Avista Colour Stain



## Finishing colour stain for use with resurfacing system and most concrete surfaces

### Uses

Dulux Avista Colour Stain is used within the resurfacing system as a secondary colour stain. It can also be used to stain plain, polished and stamped concrete. Can also stain stamped concrete, blockwork, porous pavers, bench tops and false rock.

### Advantages

- Can be applied in many ways to provide a wide range of effects
- All colours can be intermixed

### Description

Dulux Avista Colour Stain is a coloured liquid with a low odour and medium viscosity. The standard colours in the range are: red, brown, black, blue, green, white, marigold and yellow.

These can be blended to make various tones and shades. The colour dries shades deeper than when originally applied, it is therefore advisable to do a test sample first. Sealing also deepens the shade. It is recommended to keep a record of the formula for each colour created..

### Application Instructions

Shake bottle to ensure mix is homogenous. Then use colours singularly or mixed to give required colour. Dilute with water to give the chosen intensity.

Dulux Avista Colour Stain can be applied in many ways. Common methods are flood and squeegee, roller application, pad, sponge, spray and brush.

If using a pour and Squeegee method keep the stain moving as if it will settle and stain darker in that area if not kept moving.

### Limitations

Always allow the preceding coats to dry before additional application, otherwise smudging will occur.

### Coverage

Can be diluted up to 1 part to 20 parts water, depending on the colour intensity required. Area covered depends on texture. Generally 1 litre of final mix covers 10 Mtr<sup>2</sup>

### Storage

#### Shelf life

24 months, if kept in unopened container and stored in cool, dry conditions. After this time, the product should be checked for it's suitability for use.

#### Storage

Ensure containers are sealed and store in cool, dry conditions. Do not store below 0°C.
